NOTIFICATION

G. O. (P) No. 6/2012/TD. Dated, *Thiruvananthapuram, 19th January, 2012.*

S. R. O. No. 38/2012.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 18A and 29 of the Abkari Act 1 of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002 issued by notification under G.O.(P) No. 24/2002/TD dated 30th March, 2002 and published as S.R.O. No.198/2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 376 dated 30th March, 2002, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal (First Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Akbari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002 after rule 5G, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“5H. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the privilege of vending toddy for the remaining period of the financial year 2011-12 in respect of toddy shops remaining unsold as on the date of commencement of this rule, for want of eligible purchasers, shall be put to public sale subject to the relaxation in the general conditions under rule 5 that such unsold toddy shops shall be entrusted with the Worker’s Committees at a rental of Rs. 500 per month, per shop, except in Thrissur Division where the unsold toddy shops shall be sold to individuals at a rental of Rs. 500, per month per shop.”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Government, vide G.O. (Ms.) No. 203/2011/TD dated 23rd December, 2011, have decided to accord sanction to entrust the unsold toddy shops with the Worker’s Committees at a rental of Rs. 500 per month except in the case of Thrissur Division, where the unsold toddy shops will be sold to individuals at a rental of Rs. 500 per month as per Rules. To implement the above decision, the Kerala Akbari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002 needs to be amended.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
