As per the G.O. read as 1st paper above , Government appointed Sri.M.Ramachandran, Retired Judge, High Court of Kerala, as the One Man Commission for recommending parameters for formulating comprehensive Abkari Policy, and the terms of reference was prescribed vide the G.O. read as 2nd paper above . The Commission has reported that roughly an amount of Rs.2,90,000/- per month is required for the functioning of the Commission, and the report will be submitted within 3 months from the date of receipt of advance payment of Rs.7.5 lakhs.
